## 7 MILLION STUDENTS VISIT EVERYSTUDENT.COM TO FIND GOD

ORLANDO, FL, February 14, 2007 - *EveryStudent.com* has become the on-line place where college students go to get answers to their questions about God. In 2006, more than 7 million students visited [www.EveryStudent.com](http://www.EveryStudent.com) to find “a safe place to explore issues about college, life, and what it might be like to know God.”

*EveryStudent.com* was developed by Campus Crusade for Christ. The UCLA survey of 112,000 students, *Spirituality in Higher Education*, concluded that students today are on a “spiritual quest”. *EveryStudent.com* is designed to help meet the spiritual hunger of students.

“What the Roman roads were to the Apostle Paul and the printing press to Martin Luther, that’s what the Internet is for Campus Crusade for Christ today,” says Jim Topmiller, National Director of Development for Campus Crusade. “The Internet is the vehicle or tool for getting the Good News to every future leader in the world because every college student is logged on to the web.”

*EveryStudent.com* features topical articles and videos. Articles highlighted for Valentine’s Week included *Sex and the Search for Intimacy*, *Romances with Wolves* and the *Mount Rushmore Test*.

A popular feature of *EveryStudent.com* is that visitors can choose to email their questions to a specific person that they choose. The emails are sent through an anonymous system to maintain the privacy of the individuals.

“I want to help answer questions students have about God and eliminate barriers they have to wanting to know him, explains Marilyn Adamson. Adamson, co-developer and Director of *EveryStudent.com*, is a mother who runs the website from her home office. “I never expected it to grow this large.”

Last year, 85,002 students indicated decisions to place their faith in Jesus to begin a personal relationship with God while on the website. One student wrote, “I went to Google and typed in is there a god? When I got to your site and saw the list of articles, it freaked me out. Every single question I had, it was all right there... I just prayed “Yeah, what it says on the screen, God, I want that; I want to know you.”

*EveryStudent.com* is now available in sixteen languages, including four versions of English.
